We are now in our second month and July is just around the corner. Start thinking of our *Hot Pots* Soup night and our Exhibition (more on that soon) July will be here before we know it.

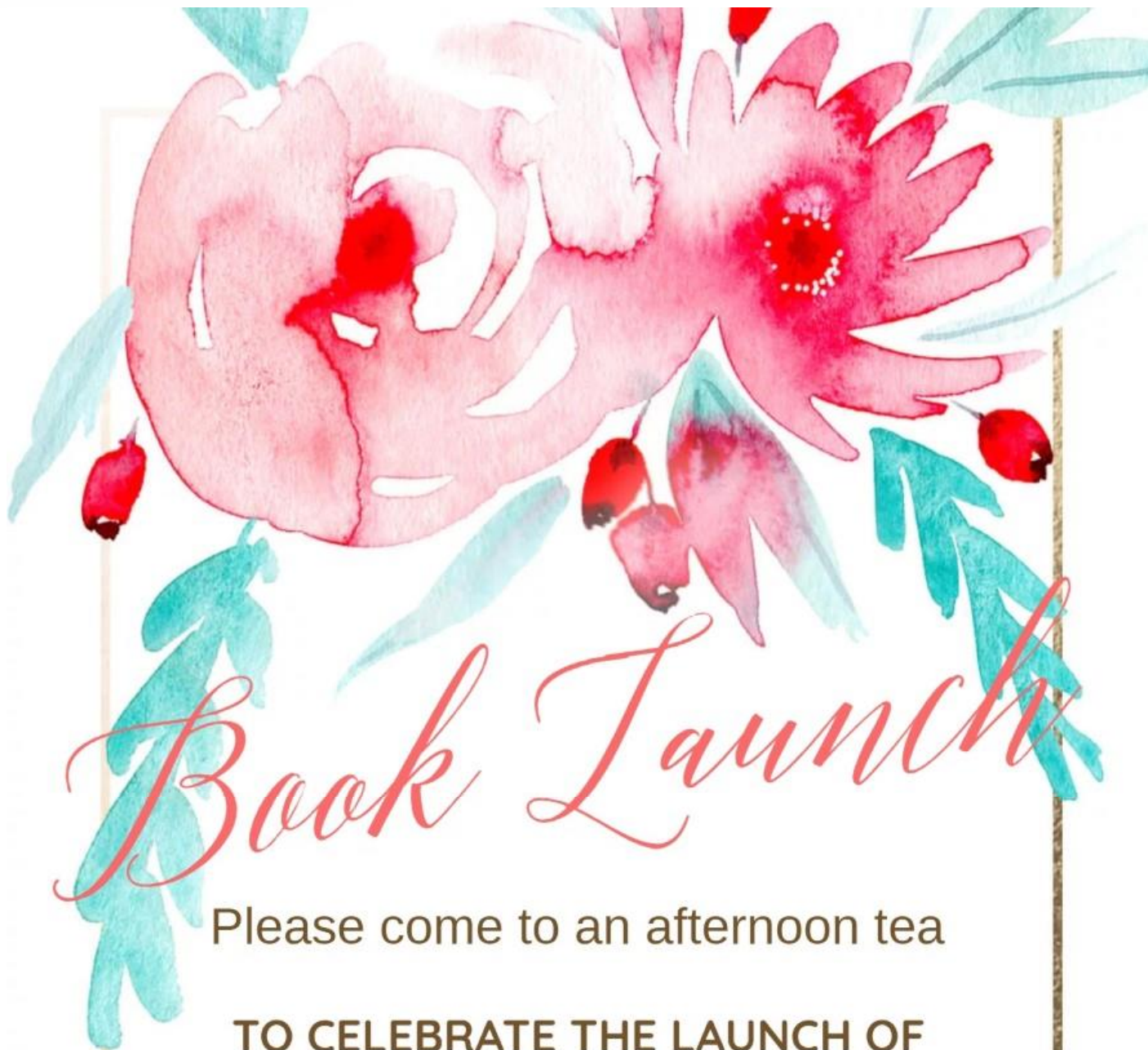
